General Academic Support for Students

- ◆ Teachers are available to work with students individually or in small groups before and after school.
 - ◆ Teachers are available in study halls to help students in various subject areas including writing lab.
 - ◆ National Honor Society provides peer tutoring. Availability is determined according to student's schedule.
 - ◆ Study Skills classes are offered annually. Individual sessions are done as needed throughout the year.
 - ◆ A mentor program links a teacher with a student for support, monitoring and guidance in all subject areas.
 - ◆ Academic counselors are available to work one-on-one with students on study skills, interventions, etc.
- The counselors also help coordinate the make up schedule for students who have been absent for an extended period of time.

Students with Documented Specific Learning Needs

Two Levels of Additional Support:

Academic Support Plan—A student who needs academic support in a specific area may be eligible. This plan is based on the previous Support Plan from the grade school, physician and/or psychologist report, or result of IAT. See the sample support plan on back for types of accommodations offered. This is a document that contains accommodations a student may utilize while attending Bishop Watterson High School, and does not extend to state and national standardized tests.

Academic Services Plan—A student who has an identified Specific Learning Disability(s) or Communication Disorder(s) may be eligible. A Services Plan (similar to an IEP) is based on a Evaluation Team Report (ETR) which includes detailed results of achievement and cognitive testing, and a description of the diagnosed disability. The Services Plan lists the accommodations for which the student is eligible. See sample services plan for types of accommodations offered. Note: Accommodations for students on Services Plans may include working with the Intervention Specialists/Tutors.
