Saturday, May 23	Students report to freshman hall classrooms in caps and gowns, 9:00 – 9:10 a.m. Students enter through the main office lobby Parents enter through Dominican Hall with ticket to scan Graduation, 9:30 a.m. BWHS – doors open at 8:45 a.m.

Students do not have to participate in Baccalaureate and Graduation. It is your parents' and your choice. However, if you decide to be a part of the graduation ceremonies, you and those invited commit to a positive code of behavior. Attendance at both events is mandatory. If a student decides not to participate, he/she must have a note from his/her parents indicating and approving the decision. This note is necessary prior to May 15. In order to participate in Graduation ceremonies, you must be ON TIME and PRESENT at all practices and attend Baccalaureate.

TICKETS FOR BACCALAUREATE AND GRADUATION

No tickets will be required for Baccalaureate. Each student will receive 5 tickets for Graduation.

- There will be limited floor seating, but keep in mind seating for both ceremonies is on a first-come basis.
- Baccalaureate and Graduation will be live-streamed for those who are unable to attend.
- Ticketing will be done through HomeTown ticketing, similar to all other events.

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

Academic	--	All academic requirements must be met
Financial	--	All tuition and fees (including lunch fees, library fines, athletic uniforms, etc.) must be paid
Disciplinary	--	All fines must be paid
Practices	--	Must attend <u>all</u> Graduation and Baccalaureate practices

DRESS FOR BOTH BACCALAUREATE AND GRADUATION

Baccalaureate ceremony – Gown only
Graduation ceremony – Cap and Gown worn

Only academic or service medals achieved at BWHS may be worn on gown. These are worn on the upper right side of the gown on the lapel. Only academic or service cords achieved at BWHS may be worn. Caps, gowns, medals and cords will be distributed during graduation practices.

Men –

- Dress shirt and tie
- Dress pants
- Socks and dress shoes (no sandals, tennis shoes, crocs or boots)
- Sport coat is not required or recommended
- Must be clean shaven
- No earrings
- Hair must be appropriate length according to handbook guidelines
- No exposed tattoos

Women –

- Dress or pant suit
- Dress shoes or dress sandals (no flip flops, tennis shoes or crocs)
- Hair must be appropriate color according to handbook guidelines
- No excessive make-up or jewelry
- No exposed tattoos

FINALS

- If you are required to take a final, you must be on time.
- You are required to take your final at BWHS during the assigned class period or testing time.
- If you miss a senior final, you will receive a zero.
- Students may dress in casual attire, following ALL handbook guidelines, on May 18th – May 20th.

COMPUTER COLLECTION
